The District Administration enjoys a generous package of benefits including a:

- TSA,

These perks cost the district \$179,424 a year.

The top five and the cost of their perks are:

Phil Pendley \$39,674 in perks

Mary Wolfsburg \$36,751 in perks

Vince Christakos \$35,233 in perks

La Faye Platter \$34,190 in perks

Sally Cawthon \$33,576 in perks

At a time when the district is claiming severe economic hardship and is proposing 7% cuts in HTA member compensation, doesn't it make sense to cut the PERKS of the privileged few before harming the people who actually educate the children of the district?
